Speed dating procedure

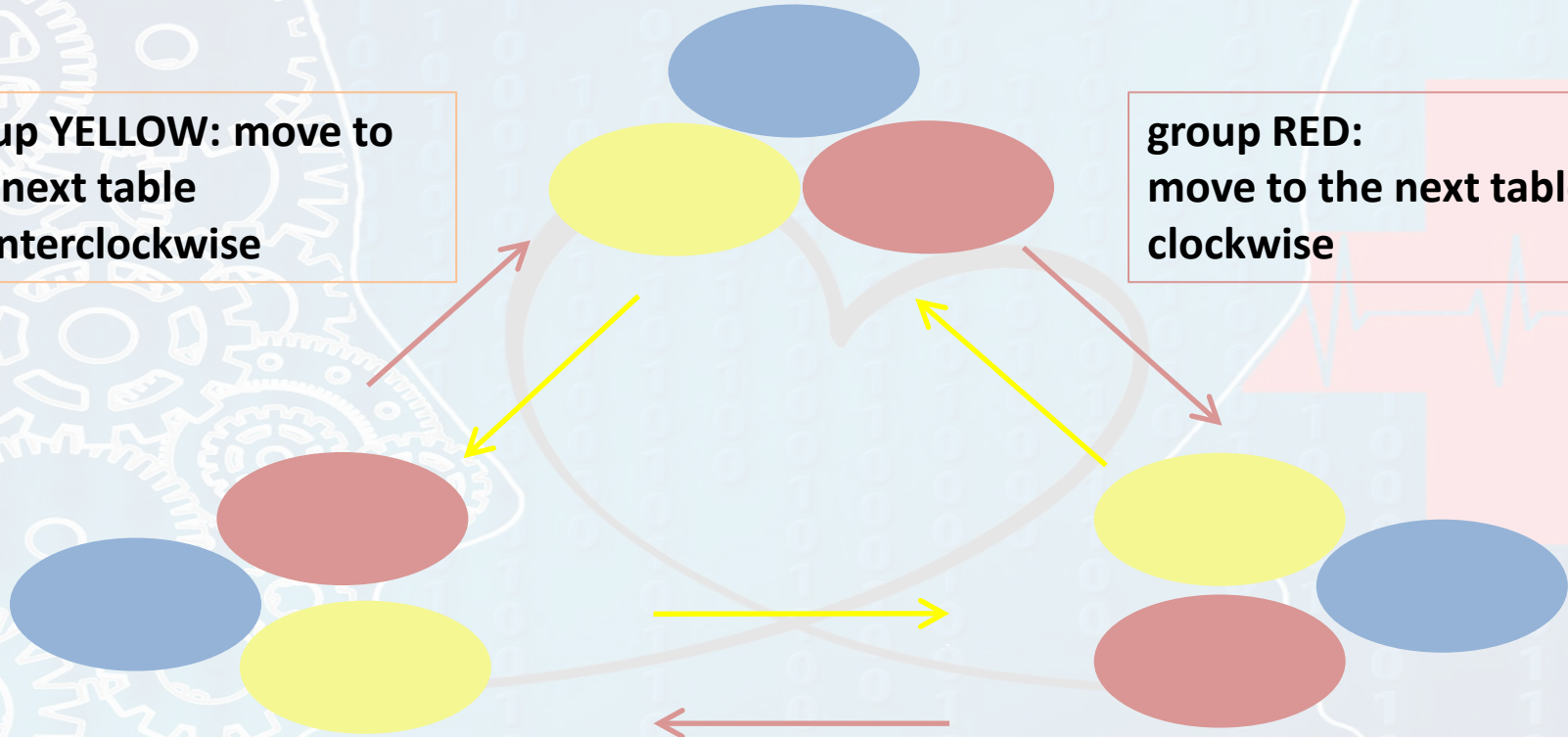
- 6 groups
- each group consists of 3 people (blue, orange, red – see nametags)
- 10 minutes per group → present your topic of interest/research in **not more than 3 minutes** (English or German) → ask questions
- when you hear the sound signal → move on to the next group (direction marked on the floor)
- everybody will have 6 group chats in total

How to switch

group BLUE: stay at your table

group YELLOW: move to the next table counterclockwise

group RED: move to the next table clockwise



Matchmaking

- After the speed dating phase you have time to have a drink, walk around and have a first more specific talk about the projects you are interested in.
- Feel free to join/leave different groups, exchange contact info etc.
- **The final matches will be defined next week**, when some more researchers are going to join us.
