### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ONLINE ADMISSION TEST MEDICAL ENGINEERING

## 1. Who needs to take an online admission test for the master's program in Medical Engineering?

Only the applicants who qualify for the test will be notified via an email from zimt-qfv@fau.de. The applicants have to pass the online admission test in order to receive admission to the program. Please check the email account you entered in our Campo portal during application as well as your spam folder regularly to see if you received an invitation.

## 2. How long in advance will I receive the email with the test invitation?

You will receive it at least 7 days in advance.

### 3. When does the test take place?

There will be two test dates per application period. You will be informed via email which test date applies to you.

On the determined test date, the test will be published on our test platform StudOn exam at 2 pm (14:00) German time. The time zone for the test is either Central European Time (CET/UTC + 1) during (German) winter or Central European Summer Time (CEST / UTC + 2) during (German) summer. Please look up to which time this corresponds in your country of residence! Please note that we cannot offer you alternative test times due to large time zone differences.

You have to start the test within the first 5 minutes after its publication. After the 5 minutes have passed, it is not possible for you to start the test anymore. We recommend that you log onto the StudOn exam platform 15 min. before the publishing of the test to ensure you can start it on time.

After the test duration of 60 minutes has ended, your current test progress will be saved and submitted (i.e., even if you couldn't click 'End Test' due to lack of time and the test is ended by the system, your answers will not be lost).

# 4. Where does the test take place?

It takes place entirely online on our test platform StudOn exam. You will have to register for the test platform with your email address and a registration code you will receive by email.

## 5. Which language will the test be in?

A: The test will be either entirely in English or entirely in German, depending on the specialization you chose during application.

# 6. What kind of equipment do I need for the test?

The most important thing (other than an awake mind) is a stable internet connection, preferably wired, and an up-to-date browser. You do not need webcams, IDEs, compilers or any special technology, software, or hardware.

#### 7. Can I retake the test?

Every applicant only gets one shot at the test per application period. Once you start the test, you have only that chance to complete it. It is not possible to cancel the test and retry later. It is not possible to take the test again to improve your result. If you take the test a second time you will be rejected, no matter your result on either test.

If you failed our admission test in the current application period, you are welcome to reapply to our program in the next application period and retake the test then.

## 8. I received a second invitation despite already having taken the test. What should I do?

As mentioned above, you are not allowed to take the test a second time. If you have falsely received a second invitation (e. g. because of a system error) please contact <a href="mailto:zimt-qfv@fau.de">zimt-qfv@fau.de</a>

### 9. What happens if I cannot take the test on the test date I was invited to?

If you cannot participate on the first date, you can take the test on the second date. However, you must **withdraw** from the first test via a short email containing your name and your applicant number to <u>zimt-qfv@fau.de.</u> If you do not take the second test either, your application will be rejected.

If you are invited to our second test date and do not participate in the test, your application will be rejected. In this case, we recommend that you reapply to our program in the next semester at the very beginning of the new application period.

### 10. What if I fail the test or do not take it at all?

Insufficient or nonexistent performance on the test will result in your application being rejected.

### 11. Which subjects will be covered in the test?

The test will assess your ability to solve tasks from the fields of mathematics, algorithms and data processing (25%) as well as from the areas of medical image and data processing/health & medical data analytics or medical robotics (75%)

The test is intended to measure whether your competences match that of our own bachelor's degree in Medical Engineering. This way we ensure that you are qualified for our master program and that you are capable of mastering your studies at FAU.

Please note that we do not provide you with mock exams or questions from past tests.

## 12. What happens after the test?

A: After the test, the results will be evaluated. This process can take up to two weeks. You will be informed via our Campo portal whether we can offer you admission to our master's program or not.
